

### Hats & Mittens

We have been working with all our little ones on independence and responsibility with putting their clothing items away. This is a long-term process (any of you with older children know they can still be working on these skills in  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$ , and  $3^{rd}$  grade or beyond)! However, when we get ready to go outdoors we encourage children to put on coats on their own. Depending on their age and ability, we will help them zip and put on hats, mittens, and other apparel. In the beginning of the season, we find that a lot of items get misplaced in other people's cubbies or in odd places in the room. Once they have a couple weeks of practice, they become more capable of putting their items in the pockets or sleeves and into their cubby. As a parent, there are a couple things you can do to help us out.

- ✓ Label your child's items with their name or initials
- ✓ Practice self-help skills with your child when you get home each day...have them take off their coats, etc. Let them know to put their items into their pockets or sleeves!
